Did you know that you can redirect a portion of your state income taxes to support Southside Christian School? Currently, your state income taxes go to Atlanta as part of the state budget. UPDATES FOR 2023

Increased Fund Cap:

\$120 million with a maximum of \$6 million from Business Enterprises.

Second Chance Provision:

Approved donations not made within 60 days will be added back to the amount of available tax credits.



NEW DONOR CATEGORY

Business Enterprise - up to 75% of state insurance premium tax liability.

Limit: \$1 million per individual Business Enterprise.

"Business Enterprise" means any insurance company or the headquarters of any insurance company required to pay Georgia insurance premium taxes.

INCREASED DONATION LIMITS

Individual - \$2,500

Up from \$1,000

Married Couple Filing Jointly - \$5,000

Up from \$2,500

Each Owner of Pass-Through entity - \$25,000

Up from \$10,000

C-Corp, Trust, or "electing" Pass-Through entity - up to 75% of state income tax liability

If you answered "yes" to either of these questions, this is your opportunity. Through Georgia's Education Tax Credit program, taxpayers are able to pre-pay a portion of their state tax liability and donate it to fund student scholarships at accredited Georgia private schools like Southside Christian School.

This isn't a "donation" in the traditional sense as it isn't any extra money out of your pocket. It's simply what you're going to pay in taxes anyway. But, now you get direct control over where your tax dollars are used.

There is ultimately no cost to donate.

Taxpayers receive a *dollar-for-dollar state tax credit* for the amount donated.

You win as a taxpayer, local students win, and Southside Christian School wins!

To Donate:

1. Go to AlynFund.org before Dec. 31st & complete a donation request form through the Paperless Donation Process.
2. In January, the Alyn Scholarship Fund will submit your donor request to the GA Dept. of Revenue for approval.
3. Make your approved donation to the Alyn Scholarship Fund in either February or March.

Maximum Donation Amounts

Individual (unwed) - **\$1,000**

Married filing Separately - **\$1,250**

Married filing Jointly - **\$2,500**

C-Corp or Trust - **75% of state tax liability**

Each Owner or Shareholder of a Pass-through entity (LLC, S-Corp, Partnership, etc) - **\$10,000**
